## Welcome

Thanks for your interest in the NSBA Small Business Regulations Survey. We aimed to cover a wide array of topics and provide a detailed perspective of how the federal regulatory regime is impacting America's smallest businesses.

While reading this report, I urge you to keep in mind that regulatory compliance falls overwhelmingly on the small-business owner, Only 1-in-10 small businesses have staff that help monitor the regulatory landscape.

Among the key findings from the survey:

- When asked approximately how much money they anticipate they would spend today in regulatory compliance costs if they were to start their exact same business, the average was a whopping \$53,305.
- More than half of respondents reported that compliance with DOL's Independent Contractor Rule was burdensome to their business.
- The #1 source of information on regulations: Business Associations like NSBA.
- The majority of respondents in this survey have fewer than 5 employees, yet "Labor" is still the top area they cite for deregulation.

Regulatory compliance goes beyond just reporting – small-business owners must read through any possibly relevant rules to determine if they even need to comply, and that takes a great deal of time. More information is NOT the same as good information.




#### Which source of regulation is most burdensome to your business?



\*Includes time spent reading regulations, developing compliance protocol, adjusting operations, etc.




→ 1-in-3 small businesses spend more than one full work week per year on federal regulations.

## If you outsource federal regulatory compliance, how much money do you spend each year on this expense?




2-in-5 small-business owners spend more than \$1,000 per year on outsourced regulatory assistance.

#### Which of the following people/departments in your business spends the most time on federal regulatory compliance?














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






#### How burdensome has compliance been with...






More than half of respondents reported that compliance with DOL's **Independent Contractor Rule was** burdensome to their business.




#### Please select how regulatory burdens and their associated costs impact your business overall. (Check all that apply)



Burdensome, unclear, and unfair regulations have real-world costs: small-business job creation and business-growth.




## Where do you find out about regulations that may impact your business? (Check all that apply)




The #1 source of information on regulations: Business Associations like NSBA. Only 1-in-10 small businesses have staff that help monitor the regulatory landscape.

3-in-5 small businesses have never used a federal agency resource to help with compliance.


If you have utilized a federal agency resource, how helpful did you find the resource(s)?





#### Have you interacted with the SBA Office of **Advocacy or Office of the National** Ombudsman?



#### In which of the following policy areas would you most support deregulation?





#### If yes, how often in the last five years has your business been fined?





Less than 1-in-10 small businesses have been fined for regulatory noncompliance, and the majority of those fined have only received one citation in the last five years. This is why safeharbor clauses in regulations are so critical: to account for the complexity facing smallbusiness owners who double as the chief regulatory officers.
